CLUB RUSH AND FRESHMEN ORIENTATION

- Ask for their contact information so you can contact them eventually
- If your school does not have club rush ask to set up a table during lunch
- Tell them the details of your next meeting
- Emphasize that Key Club is an international organization

- Have something at the booth that attracts people (ex. Candy)





POSTERS

STAY ACTIVE

- Have regulated club meetings
