<p>Do Not Wear: Flip-flops/sandals, bottoms that do not abide by the "Fingertip Rule," shirts that do not cover the midriff, cleavage baring/low cut tops, t-shirts, sneakers/tennis shoes, and/or clothing that does not cover the shoulders.</p>	

Formal

Governor's Banquet and Ball

Males:	Females:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suit with dress shirt or tuxedo • Tie/bow tie • Dress shoes 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Business/formal dress (homecoming/prom style) <i>Note: Prom style is preferred but not required</i> • Dress shoes including appropriate pumps, heels, wedges, or flats. Note: Dress does not have to cover shoulders.
<p>Do Not Wear: Flip-flops/sandals, bottoms that do not abide by the "Fingertip Rule," shirts that do not cover the midriff, cleavage baring/low cut tops, t-shirts, and/or sneakers/tennis shoes.</p>	

The "Fingertip Rule" means that no fingertip may extend beyond the hem of a dress or skirt while standing upright. This rule also applies to any slits or cuts in the skirt or dress.
